Our Lenten cross projects are looking beautiful.

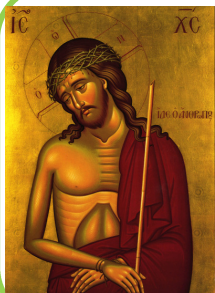
Our caterpillars arrive next week!
