ORTHODOX MISSIONS AND GREAT LENT.....

"GO AND MAKE DISCIPLES OF ALL NATIONS...."(Matthew 28:19)

Our Lord Jesus commanded His disciples to become missionaries. He desired that people of all nations hear and receive His gospel (GOOD NEWS!). The OCMC (Orthodox Christian Mission Center) is the official mission ministry of all canonical Orthodox jurisdictions in America. It conducts a worldwide ministry to bring the good news of Christ to all people. When people repent of their sins and accept the "good news" of Christ, they become spiritually reborn. They acknowledge Christ as their Lord and God. The Apostle Paul describes believers as "*new creations*" in whom Christ dwells. (*II Corinthians 5:17*)

OCMC missionaries themselves undertake the task to teaching the gospel to people of all nations and places. We greatly honor our missionaries. They offer their skills from all walks of life as teachers, priests, nurses, doctors, builders, engineers, etc. so others can learn about new spiritual life in Christ. Today OCMC missionaries are serving in many countries (e.g. Albania, Mexico, Guatemala, Kenya, Uganda, South Korea, Ghana, the Congo, New Zealand, Mozambique, and more.)

1. RESURRECTION APOLYTIKION (Fourth Mode)

Having learned the joyful proclamation of the Resurrection from the angel, and having cast off the ancestral condemnation, the women disciples said to the Apostles triumphantly: Death is despoiled and Christ God is risen, granting great mercy unto the world.

2. HYMN OF OUR CHURCH (Fourth Mode)

Today is the beginning of our salvation, and the revelation of the mystery of ages. The Son of God becomes the Son of the Virgin. And Gabriel proclaims this gift from God. Together with him we cry out to You, O Theotokos: "Hail thou full of grace, the Lord is with you."

3. KONTAKION (Plagal Second Mode)

O guide to wisdom, provider of prudence, disciplinarian of fools, and defender of the poor, fortify and discipline my heart, O Master; You give me a word, O Word of the Father. For behold, I will not hinder my lips from crying to You: O merciful Lord, have mercy on me who have fallen.
